

Sochi Olympics partners unveil exclusive packages

The company Jet Set Sports, a partner of organizational committee of the Sochi Olympics has begun selling tickets to the Olympics and hotel rooms, Vedomosti reported on Monday.

The packages are worth from 81,000 rubles (\$2,500) to 670,000 rubles (\$ 20.782), the paper reported.

“For example, the hockey program (semifinals, final, and third place play-off), which includes four nights in the three star hotel Zelyonaya Roshcha, will cost 266,642 rubles (about \$ 8,200) for one person or 445,476 rubles for two. The most expensive package is a weekly program including the figure skating competition and the Olympics closure ceremony. The tickets and rooms in the four star hotel Zhemchushchina will cost 440,000 rubles and 670,000 rubles, respectively,” the paper has reported.

All programs include breakfast, the use of city transport on the days of the competitions, and a gift, Vedomosti reported.

Plane and train tickets to Sochi and transfers are not included in the programs, Vedomosti reported.

A representative of Jet Set Sports told Vedomosti that only the company can sell packages.

Sports lovers from Russia, Australia, Bulgaria, Brazil, Canada, the UK, Norway, Sweden, and the U.S. can buy these packages, he said.

The representative of Jet Set Sports reiterated that people can also buy packages with tickets to specific competitions at a price starting from 81,083 rubles for two people, programs for lovers of a specific sport (from 129,256 rubles per two people), and packages with a set of tickets to specific competitions (from 211,763 rubles for two people).
